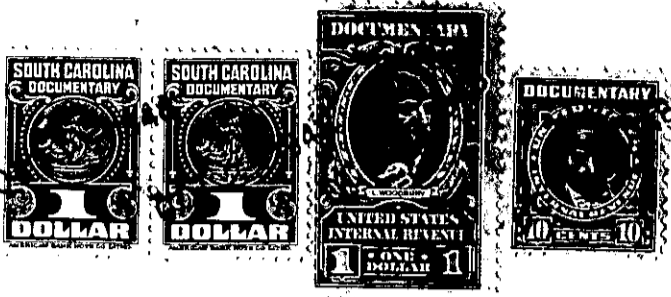

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, siuate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a corner in center of Cooley's Bridge Road running N38-30W 306.0 feet to corner, thence N34-30W 265.0 feet, to corner, thence N65-30W 125.0 feet to corner on line of Gettys Knight, thence N46-45E along the line of Gettys Knight 330.0 feet, to corner, thence S55-30E along line of Adger Cothran 314.0 feet to corner, thence S50-30E 306.0 feet to corner in center of the said Cooley's Bridge Road, thence along the said road 460 feet to the beginning corner, as per plat made by W. C. Clinkscales Jr. Surveyor, dated October 7th 1948.
