(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said TRUSTEES OF TERRY CREEK PENTECOSTAL HOLINESS CHURCH, their successors and assigns:-

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:-

BEGINNING at a stake in the Terry Creek Road where plantation road leads from said Terry Creek Road through the property now or formerly belonging to F. C. Bright, and running thence along the said Terry Creek road in a northwesterly direction 178 feet to dogwood and sourwood; thence in a northeasterly direction 256 feet to a sourwood and maple at plantation road above mentioned; thence in an easterly direction 192 feet to a maple and red oak; thence in a southwesterly direction 256 feet to the beginning corner, and containing $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less.
