Know All Men by These Presents, That I, Daniel Johnson

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the
 sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars
 to me paid by Willis E. Heaton
 in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
 have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said Willis E. Heaton, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being
 situate in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County, Bates
 Township, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin in old road Northeast of Clyde Colman's
 house; thence N56½W 990 feet to an iron pin; thence N25E 825 feet
 to an iron pin which is on the Pickens line; thence S65E 660 feet
 to an iron pin on Railroad right-of-way; thence down edge of rail
 road right-of-way 640 feet to an iron pin on right-of-way; thence
 S47½W 572 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, containing
 Twenty (20) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the West
 by the Grantor, Pickens land on the North, East G & N Railroad,
 and on the South by Coleman land.
