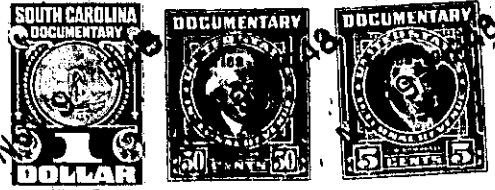

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. T. Stover

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being Lot No. 118 fronting on Woodville Avenue according  
to Plat No. 3, property of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville Investment Company  
made by R. T. Dalton, Engineer, January 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office  
for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 218 and being more particularly described  
as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Woodville Avenue and running thence along Woodville  
Avenue, N. 52-53 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 118 and  
119; thence S. 47-49 E. 168 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 8-06 W. 97.4 feet to an iron  
pin; thence N. 89-16 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 117 and  
118; thence N. 32-12 W. 204 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
