Highway No. 29, and known and designated as Cemetery Street and Bennett Street of the T. D. Bennett sub-division, as shown by plat made by G. Sam Lowe, Registered, C. E., dated August 24, 1948, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, page 143, and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Said Cemetery Street having a width of 30 feet and a length of approximately 834 feet, and running from the said Highway to the Pelzer Manufacturing Company property line.

Said Bennett Street having a width of 30 feet and a length of approximately 682 feet, and running from the said Highway to the Pelzer Manufacturing Company property line.
