in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wallace C. Steele, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 38 of the property of J. M. Harris as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, at page 146, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of Carolina avenue and Gordon street, and running thence along the south side of Gordon street, N. 74-30 E. 130 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 45; thence along the line of that lot, S. 15-10 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 37; thence along the line of that lot, S. 74-30 W. 130 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Carolina avenue; thence along the East side of Carolina avenue, N. 15-10 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
