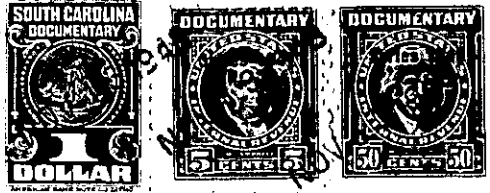

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That... We, Mrs. J. H. Alewine, G. W. Alewine and Ansel Alewine, partners trading as Taylors Lumber Company in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of... Four Hundred Thirty-Seven and... No/100... (\$437.00)... Dollars to... US... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by... W. R. Julian... (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said... W. R. Julian, his Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All those lots of land situate, lying and being on the East side of hard-surfaced road, sometimes referred to as St. Mark Road, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lots 7 and 8 on plat of property of Eugene A. McConnell, made by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, November 18, 1946, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "Q", page 95, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of St. Mark Road at joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7, and running thence along the line of Lot 6 N. 64-53 E. 175 feet to iron pin; thence N. 22-00 W. 100 feet to iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 9, S. 64-53 W. 175 feet to iron pin on East side of St. Mark Road; thence with the East side of said Road S. 22-00 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to us by Eugene A. McConnell by deed dated Dec. 4, 1946, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 307, page 233.
