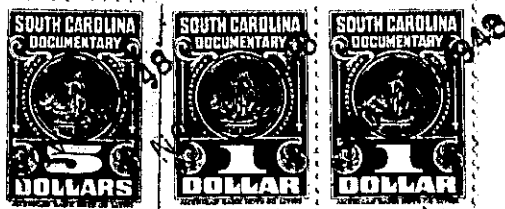

All that piece, parcel or lot of land located on the West side of the Laurens Road in School District 7-H near the Laurel Creek School, containing 6.30 acres, more or less, according to a plat made in February, 1940 by Dalton & Neves and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of the Laurens Road corner of I. P. Kellett property and running thence N. 88-15 W. 568 feet to an old pin; thence N. 1-37 E. 614 feet to an old pin on line of property now or formerly belonging to J. V. Jones; thence along the J. V. Jones line, N. 75-0 E. 269.5 feet to an iron pin on the West side of the Laurens Road; thence along the West side of the Laurens Road, S. 22-36 E. 752.4 feet to the point of beginning.
