"All that piece, parcel and tract of land known as a part of Tract No. two of Pleasant Coxe's Estate and Tract No. One which was conveyed to us by deed from Luther Cox, adjoining land of Noah Cox, Bud Cutch, and Saluda Lumber Co.

BEGINNING on a burnt pine running thence N. 20 W. 17.50 chs. Stake P.O. gone; thence S. 85 W. 12.00 to Hickory of lot No. Two; thence the same direction 11.00 to stake corner of Noah Coxes land; thence S. 15 E. 37.25 to a stone, running thence N. 69 E. 9.70 to a stone; thence N. 28 1/2 E. 29.50 to the beginning corner and contains 119 acres, the same more or less.
