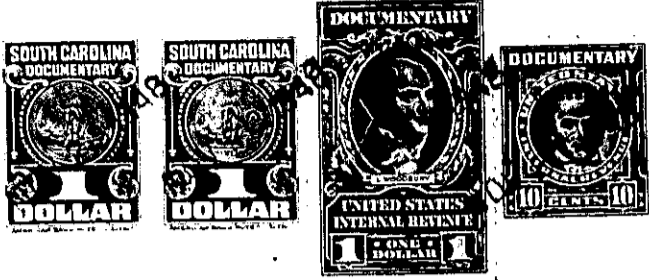

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, J. J. Moody
of the County of Greenville,
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00)
Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Allen E. Vaughn
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Allen E. Vaughn, his heirs
and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, marked "sold" on plat of property of S. L.
Styles, made May 11, 1939, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "K", at page 4, near the
intersection of Franklin Road and Berkley Avenue, and having, accord-
-ing to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of Franklin Road, joint
corner of lot No. one (1), and running thence N. 57-02 E. two hundred
(200) feet to a point, corner of lot No. seven (7); thence S. 32-58
E. sixty-five (65) feet to point at western corner of Lot No. seven
(7); thence S. 57-02 E. two hundred (200) feet to point on the northern
side of Franklin Road; thence along the northern side of Franklin Road
S. 28-11 E. sixty-five (65) feet to the beginning corner; and being a
portion of the property conveyed to H. W. Barton by S. L. Styles by
deed dated July 14, 1939, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County in Deed Book 218 at page 107.
