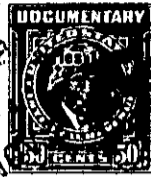
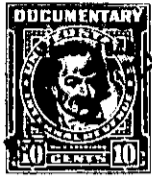

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the White Horse Road, and known and designated as Lots Nos. forty nine (49) and fifty (50) on a plat of the property of Bertie E. Burns recorded in the R. M. C.
