and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Molid R. Reese,
Mrs. Minnie Reese Barton, Mrs. Elizabeth Reese Shumpert, I. F. Reese, Benjamin
P. Reese, David W. Reese, Jr., and A. Foster Reese,
and their heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located between the Saluda Gap road and the road leading from the Greenville Court House to Rutherfordton, North Carolina, and beginning at a stone, 3x, on the Saluda-Gap road, A. T. Reese's corner, and runs with his line to a stake in the Greenville and Rutherfordton road; thence with said Rutherfordton road to where the said road crosses the road leading to Mays Bridge; thence along Mays road to the Saluda-Gap road; thence along the Saluda Gap road to the beginning stone corner, and containing Fifteen acres, more or less, and being all of the same tract of land conveyed to me by S. B. Crowley by deed dated the 12th. day of September, 1900 which is recorded in the Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Vol., J. J. J. at page 176.

Also all of that certain tract of land, situate, lying and being in said State and County, O'Neal township, on the east side of the Rutherford-Greer top-soil road, near O'Neal School House, and beginning at a large oak in the forks of the road in front of Naoh and Mitchell's store and running thence N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10. Chs., to an iron pin between three oak stumps; thence N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 21.20 Chs. to a stone by a tree on West bank of branch, O. M. Mitchell's corner; thence down the meanderings of same branch about 12.00 chs., to an iron pin in the branch below bridge; thence S. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 8.31 chs., to a poplar, 3x, on east bank of another branch; thence up the meanderings of branch about 8.50 chs., to an iron pin the fork of this and another branch; thence up the left hand fork about 8.50 chs., to another fork (iron pin); thence up the right hand branch N. 66 W. 1.60 chs., to a black gum, 3x, o. m., above spring; thence S. 41. E. 3.37 chs., to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence S. 66 E. 3.07 chs., to an iron pin west side of road, corner agreed to by I. F. and D. W.
