Personally appears before me Mrs Melville Mauldin ne Miss Melville Martin a citizen of the City of Greenville, State and County above stated, who upon being duly sworn says that on the 23 day of January in the year 1906 she became the mother of a Girl Child, which child is now with, and in the care and guardianship of Mrs Margaret Stephens, who is also a resident of the City of Greenville.

And believing it would be for the best interest of the aforesaid Child, she does now declare that she does forever waive all right of possession to the child, or claim any right of possession or control over it, and by this agreement she surrenders to Mrs Stevens absolute, full, and complete care, keeping and ownership of the Child forever, and she will never either by law or otherwise make any demand for, or in any way claim by right of being its mother, endeavor to obtain possession of it, but does hereby make an absolute, full and complete surrender of all right over and to the aforesaid child, and she will forever protect and defend Mrs Margaret M Stevens in having and holding control and possession of the Child as her own.
