PERSONALLY comes before me John Abner who on oath says: That he is a brother of Glenn Abner who died the 27th day of August, 1947. His wife, was Mary Abner and she died before he did leaving no will and left Glenn Abner, her husband, and her brothers and sisters hereafter named. Glenn Abner left as his only heirs at law and distributees, John Abner, Tessie Bennan, Rachel Fleming, Carrie Reid, Allian McClinton (Irene McClinton) Alma Reid is the daughter of Carrie Reid but her mother, Carrie Reid, is still living; A deceased brother, Hayes Abner whose only heirs at law were Geneva Davis and Genevieve Pearson, and all of the above named persons are over the age of twenty one years and free from all disability. The mother, Sarah Abner, died in 1948. Those constitute all of the heirs at law of Glenn Abner. Mary Abner, his wife, having died prior to Glenn Abner in 1926, and she left as her heirs at law her husband, Glenn Abner, her father, Jeff Sullivan and the following brothers and sisters, Ora Sullivan, Wade Sullivan, Garfield Sullivan, Irby Sullivan and Gracie Sullivan all of the above named persons were over the age of twenty one years and free from disability in 1948, and all of them were of age and free from disability in March, 1926.
