to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Byron E. Reeves, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property:

All property of every kind and nature whatsoever now owned by Graceland Cemetery, Inc., including any and all easements, rights-of-way or interests of any kind in real estate, together with all buildings, tools, office equipment, supplies, contracts, accounts receivable and all other personal property whatsoever.

Included in the real estate covered by this deed is the property acquired by said corporation by deeds from Greenville Cemetery Association and Ernestine M. McMahan by deeds recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Books 218 at page 138 and 349 at page 213, respectively, less, however, all conveyances heretofore made by said corporation.
