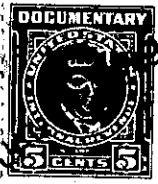

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as Lot No. 21 of a
subdivision known as Hillside Heights of the Overbrook Property as
shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Plat Book F, at page 100, and having the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Circle street
at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21 and running thence along
the joint line of said lots, S. 40-23 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at
the joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 56-18 W. 100 feet to
an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22; thence
along the joint line of said lots, N. 25-03 W. 150 feet to the joint
corner of said lots on the south side of Circle Street; thence along
the south side of said Circle street, N. 65-32 E. 60 feet to the
beginning corner.
