I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Charles H. Satterfield, Individually and as Administrator  
of the Estate of C. A. Satterfield, et al,

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said J. A. Satterfield, Kathleen Satterfield and Helen Satterfield

"All that certain tract of land lying in Gantt Township, County  
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as  
Tract No. 4 in the subdivision of the lands of C. A. Satterfield, de-  
ceased, as shown on plat thereof, made by John C. Smith, on August 2 &  
16, 1948, and being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "I", Page 89, containing 21.9 acres, more or less,  
and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances,  
as shown by said plat, to-wit:
