"All that certain parcel or tract of land in Grove Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 42 acres, more or less, known and designated as part of the J. A. Garrett property, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a pin in center of public road and running thence with said road in a northeasterly direction 1125 feet, more or less, to a pin in center of said road; thence N. 78 W. 168.75 feet to a stone; thence N. 61 W. 775.5 feet to a poplar on branch; thence in a southwesterly direction with branch as the line 1650 to a stone on branch; thence S. 70 E. 2066.25 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, bounded by lands now or formerly of McCuen and others, and being same land which was conveyed by W.
