of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Lola J. Phillips

"All those certain lots of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, South of the Old Easley
Bridge Road leading from Greenville to Easley and West of the Old Dunham
Bridge Road and known and designated as Lots Nos. 5, 19, 20 and 21, as
shown on a subdivision and plat of the Arthur J. Phillips property, made
by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, in April of 1948, which plat is of record in
the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 97, and hav-
ing the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by
said plat, to-wit:
