All that certain lot of land in Greenville County, Gantt Township, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 83, according to plat of property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, said lot having the following metes and bounds as shown by plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 113:

Beginning at a point on the southern side of Brook Forest Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 82 and 83 and running thence along the line of Lot 82 S. 38-20 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 82; thence N. 51-40 W. 80 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot 84; thence along the line of Lot 84 N. 38-20 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on Brook Forest Drive; thence along Brook Forest Drive S. 51-40 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
