

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Sullivan Street and being the northern portion of lot No. 18 of Block 3, page 95, of the City Block Book, said lot being particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Sullivan Street, northwest corner of lot formerly owned by William Patton, and being approximately 101.5 feet from the northwest corner of the intersection of Sullivan Street and Sullivan Alley, and running thence in a southerly direction along line of the Patton lot 85 feet to an iron pin; thence running in a westerly direction in a line running parallel with Sullivan Street 42.6 feet to an iron pin on a ten foot alley; thence along line of said alley in a northerly direction to an iron pin on the south side of Sullivan Street to an iron pin approximately 45 feet from the point of beginning; thence along Sullivan Street in an easterly direction 45 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, and being a portion of the property willed to me by my late husband, Thomas M.
