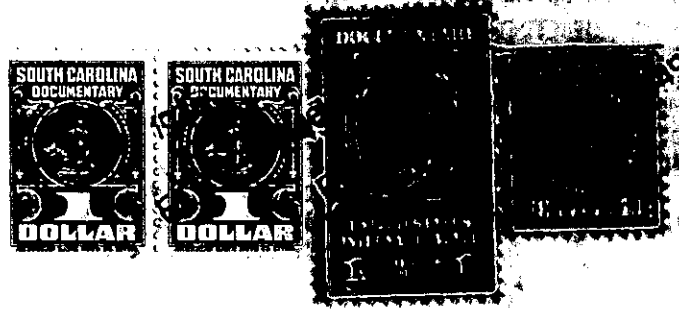

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Lillian Hunt,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. A. Farr

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. A. Farr, his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Lily Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 16 and 17 of a subdivision of the property of Lillian Hunt as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book U, at page 9, and having, in the aggregate, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Lily Street at the corner of Lot No. 18, which point is 363.2 feet east of the intersection of the Parker road, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 18, S. 26-27 E. 314.5 feet to an iron pin in line of the property of Homer Farr; thence along the line of that property, N. 54-07 E. 137.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 15; thence along the line of that lot, N. 21-44 W. 293 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Lily Street; thence along the line of said Lily Street, S. 63-28 W. 160 feet to the beginning corner.
