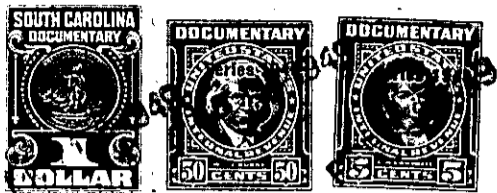

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs Mary Bishop

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
One Hundred & Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Theron Hayes

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Theron Hayes

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Spring Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

About one mile north of Chick Springs and lying east of St. Mark Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 and half of Lot No. 13 adjacent to each other of a subdivision of the W. B. Williams property and having in the aggregate the following metes and bounds according to plot and survey by H. L. Dunahoo, S.E., Jan. 21, 1947, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book 2 page 121;

However, the first line (the line that divides lot no. 13) is not on the plat the lot no. 13 being shown as whole on plat.

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of a county road at point which is the middle of Lot No. 13 and running thence S 29-40 E 150 feet to a stake corner to be in middle of Lot No. 13, thence running with lines of Lot Nos. 42 and 41 N. 65-30 E. 75 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 15, and running thence with line of Lot No. 15 in a Northwesterly direction 150 feet to a stake on the south side of a county road; and thence with said county road S. 62-48 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described land is part of the same conveyed to me by Robert L. Bryant on the 24th day of September 1947, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 328 Page 17

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Theron Hayes, his

Heirs and Assigns forever.
