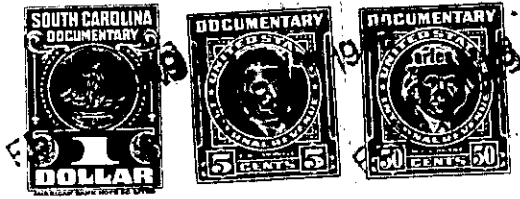

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert J. L. Styles and Ruth Styles

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township Greenville

County, State of South Carolina located on the northwesterly side of Loler road and being known as Lot No. 15 and the Eastern and adjoining half of Lot No 14 of Meadowbrook Farms, a plat of which is recorded in the P. L. C. Office for said County in Plat Book 1, at pages 22 and 23 and having according to said plat, the following notes and bounds to-wit:

Begin at an iron pin on the northwesterly side of Loler road, which iron pin is 551 feet from rear line of lot No. 15 and 10 feet from rear corner of lots nos. 15 and 10; thence along the joint line of said lots nos. 15 and 10 27.5 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of lot No. 15 27.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of the line of lot No. 14; thence through the center of Lot No 14 27.5 feet to an iron pin in the line of Loler road, the center of the front line of lot No. 14; thence along the northwesterly side of Loler road 27.5 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is subject to certain building restrictions.
