All those three lots or parcels of land known and designated as lots numbers 2, 3 on a plat of property of Nannie D. Furman, as recorded in Plat Book F, Page 296, together with the 17 foot driveway shown on the plat in the rear of lots numbers 2 and 3. The said parcel of land is located at the northeast corner of Capers Street and Camille Street (Camille Street is shown on the plat as a 30 foot street without name), in the City of Greenville, and is the same lot of land conveyed to George Cahaly by Nell G. Parrish and T. C. Gower by deed dated Sept. 13, 1945, recorded in Deed Book 280, Page 243. The lot of land is in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, begins on Capers Street at the northern edge of Camille Street and runs thence along the eastern side of Cleveland Street N. 5-41 W. 160 feet to corner on lot number 69 of Crescent Terrace; thence N. 84-19 E. 213.8 feet to corner; thence S. 2-08 E. 160 feet to corner on the northern side of Camille Street; thence along the northern side of Camille Street S. 81-30 W. 195.2 feet to the beginning corner. Included in the above description is the 17 foot driveway shown on the plat and mentioned and referred to in the deed from Parrish and Gower to George Cahaly.
