The party of the first part also agrees to release the party of the second part from any duties, responsibilities or liabilities in any manner growing out of and arising from said attempted marriage.

The party of the second part does hereby voluntarily and for the consideration herein expressed forever release, renounce, relinquish and discharge any property which the party of the first part may have or may hereinafter acquire from any claim or dower or inheritance. This being specifically done by the attached Renunciation of Dower which is made a part of this contract.

It is agreed that this contract is fully binding on both parties hereto and is irrevocably and the consideration for this contract is the money paid by the party of the first part as herein stated, the emoluments and releases and discharges of the party of the first part and the party of the second part by each other as herein expressed.
