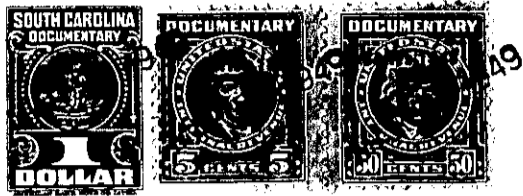

presents by Frank J. Childress and Alice B. Childress-----
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released,
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said-----

Frank J. Childress and Alice B. Childress, and their heirs and assigns
 forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Sumter Street, near the
 Town of Greer, and being known and designated as lot No. 43 on plat of
 Development No. 2 Victor-Monaghan Co., Division of J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc.,
 Greer Plant, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1947, and recorded
 in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book P, at page 119, and
 having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Sumter Street
 at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 43 and 44, and running thence with
 said street N. 33-18 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of
 lots Nos. 42 and 43; thence N. 56-36 W. 190.5 feet to an iron pin on a 10
 foot alley; thence with the line of said alley S. 33-22 W. 100 feet to an
 iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots 43 and 44; thence with joint
 line of said lots Nos. 43 and 44 S. 56-36 E. 190.7 feet to an iron pin on
 Sumter street, the beginning corner, and being all of the same lot of land
 conveyed to me by William H. Jones by deed dated the 9th., day of October
 1948
