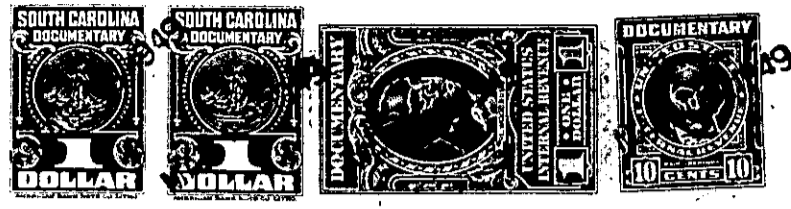

Lot No. 16 of the J. P. Rosamond property as shown on revised plat
by Dalton & Neves dated April, 1931, recorded in Plat Book H at Page
136, from which the following description is taken:

Beginning at an I.P. on the southern side of Franklin Rd., joint
corner of lots 15 and 16, and running thence with the southern edge
of Franklin Road N. 64-45 W. 60' to the joint front corner of lots
16 and 17 on Franklin Road; thence along the joint line between these
lots S. 25-15 N. 160' to the joint rear corners of lots 17 and 36,
and 16 and 37; thence along the joint rear line between lots 16 and 37
S. 64-45 E. 60' to the joint rear corner of lots 16 and 37, 15 and 38;
thence along the joint line between lots 15 and 16 N. 25-15 E. 150'
to the beginning corner on Franklin Road.
