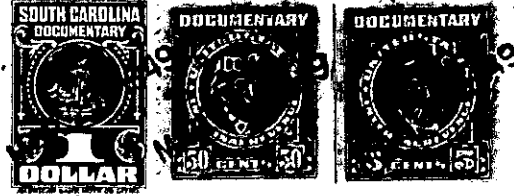

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Tom Reid,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. E. Fowler, his Heirs and
Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, located on the east side of the Roberts Road,
being bounded on the north by lands of Roberts, on the east by other
lands of myself, on the south by a one acre lot being conveyed this
day to Mrs. Maude Vaughn, and on the west by the said Roberts Road
and lands of J. E. Fowler, and being a part of the same land that
was conveyed to me by deed recorded in the office of the R. W. C.
for Greenville County in Deed Book 357 at page 498, and having
the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on a point in the said Roberts Road, joint corner
of the one acre lot being conveyed to Mrs. Maude Vaughn, and runs
thence with the Vaughn line S. 72-15 E. 375.5 feet to an iron pin;
thence N. 24-30 E. 604 feet to an iron pin on the Roberts line;
thence with the Roberts line N. 75-15 W. 378 feet to a point in
the said Roberts Road (iron pin on east side of the road);
thence with the said road S. 24-30 W. 583 feet to the beginning
point of beginning, and containing Five (5) acres, more or less.
