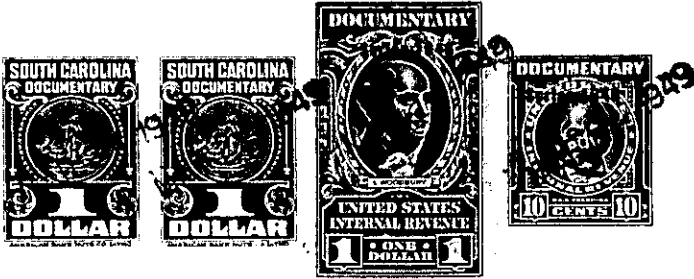

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. S. Fox, his Heirs and Assigns, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southeast side of Mills Avenue, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as lot No. 33 of Block "B" on Plat of Woodland subdivision made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February 24, 1938, recorded in the R. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "J", pages 70 and 71, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Mills Avenue, at joint front corner of lots Nos. 32 and 33 of Block "B", and running thence along the line of lot No. 32, S.40-13 E., 186.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S.49-38 W., 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-13 W., 176.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Mills Avenue; thence along the Southeast side of Mills Avenue, N.38-28 E., 51 feet to the beginning corner.
