of South Carolina, on the South side of First Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 6 as shown on plat of property of Sunny Slope, prepared by R. E. Dalton, May 1919, recorded in Plat Book "F", at page 86, and being more particularly described according to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South Side of First Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7, which pin is 146.8 feet Southeast of the intersection of First Avenue and Charleston Street and running thence with the joint line of said lots South 23-49 West 150 feet to an iron pin; thence South 66-11 East 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 5 and 6; thence with the joint line of said lots, North 23-49 East 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of First Avenue; thence with said Avenue North 66-11 West 50 feet to the beginning corner and being one of the lots conveyed to me by Henry R. Fuller by deed dated Dec. 27, 1948 and recorded in Deed Book 369, at page 36, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
