THREE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTEEN & NO/100 (\$3715.00) - - dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

GEORGE H. PAINTER AND LILA S. PAINTER

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Dunean Mills Village, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 13, Section 2, as shown on a plat entitled "Sub-division for Dunean Mills, Greenville, S. C.", made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, Greenville, S. C., on June 7, 1948, revised June 15, 1948, and August 7, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at pages 173-177, inclusive. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 56 Duke Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 69.8 feet.

The grantor and its predecessors in title have granted unto Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District, Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greenville, S. C., Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission, Greenville Traction Company, Duke Power Company and its predecessors, Southern Power Company and Southern Public Utilities Company, to one or more of them and/or to others all water and sewer pipe lines (other than house lines), electric light and power lines, including all pipe (other than house water and sewer lines), valves, fittings, hydrants, manholes, poles, wires, transformers, regulators, and other apparatus and equipment used in connection with, or forming a part of, the water, fire protection, electric light and power distribution, and sewerage systems of the village known as Dunean Mills Village in which the above described lot is located together with rights of way and easements to go upon the land for the purpose of maintenance, repair, alteration, replacement and operation (including meter reading) of the lines and systems aforesaid and of certain other water, sewer, electric and street trolley power lines constructed or to be constructed, and to relocate certain of such lines so as to run them in, along, above or near the streets and alleyways located in Dunean Mills Village and to operate and maintain the lines as so relocated, all as will more fully appear by reference to the records in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

There is excepted and excluded from this conveyance so much of the personal property above mentioned as may be located upon the lot above described and this conveyance is made subject to the rights of way and easements above mentioned insofar as they may affect said lot.

This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions:

- (1) That the lot above described shall not be sold, leased or released to any negro or person of negro blood.
- (2) That no mercantile establishment shall be erected, operated or maintained on the lot above described.
- (3) That only one residence shall be erected or maintained on any one lot.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his (her or their) Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the said J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his (her or their) heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Stevens & Co., Inc., pursuant to resolutions duly adopted by its Board of Directors on January 8, 1948, and by its Finance Committee on February 4, 1948 has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and these presents to be subscribed by its duly authorized officers, R. Henry, as Vice President and Ernest Folger, Jr., as Assistant Secretary, on the 1st day of MARCH in the year of our Lord one thousand, nine hundred and forty-nine, and in the one hundred and seventy-third year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.

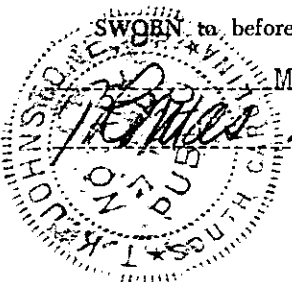
