all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, on the north side of Sunrise Drive, and  
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Sunrise Drive, corner of Lot No. 9,  
and running thence N.26-27 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence in  
a line parallel to Sunrise Drive, 99 feet to a stake; thence  
S. 27-40 W. 200 feet to Sunrise Drive; thence with Sunrise  
Drive, S. 59-40 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning, and  
being known as lot No. 7 Section A, Development Caesar's  
Head as per plat of R. E. Dalton, October 9, 1924, see  
Plat Book G, page 123 and being the same lot conveyed to  
Lavinia G. Chapman by Paris Mountain-Caesar's Head Company  
by deed dated June 5, 1926, recorded in the office of  
R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 116 at page 122,  
subject to the conditions and restrictions as therein set
