(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Nora Lee Swindle,  
 my undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina in School District 6-E, on the Old Easley Bridge Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision known as Camilla Park Map No. 2, made in December 1943, by W. J. Riddle, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, Page 85, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING At an iron pin at the Southwest corner of the intersection of the Old Easley Bridge Road and Mary Street, and running thence along the West side of Mary Street, S. 32-55 E. 200 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 66; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 66, S. 46-00 W. 82 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of Lot No. 2, N. 37-00 W. 199.6 feet to an iron pin on the South side of the Old Easley Bridge Road; thence along said Road N. 46-59 E. 96 feet to the point of beginning.

This lot is shown on the Township Block Book as Lot No. 9, Block 6, Page 241.

Being the same property conveyed to me and to Nora Lee Swindle by deed dated April 23, 1946, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 293, Page 400.

ALSO All my undivided one-half (1/2) interest in and to all that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot 66, except a ten-foot alley in the rear, according to the plat of Camilla Park No. 2 recorded in Plat Book M, Page 85, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING At the northwest intersection of Flora Avenue and Mary Street and thence with Flora Street S. 44-05 W. 80 feet to corner of Lot 65 feet on Flora Avenue; thence with Lot 65, N. 38-43 W. 189.5 feet to a ten-foot alley (established in the deed from George W. Kelly to G. W. Swindle, Jr., and Nora Lee Swindle); thence with alley N. 44 E. 90 feet, more or less, to west side of Mary Street; thence with Mary Street S. 32-55 E. 190 feet to the beginning corner.

The ten-foot alley cut from the rear of this Lot No. 66 is reserved for the joint use of George W. Kelley and G. W. Swindle, Jr.,
