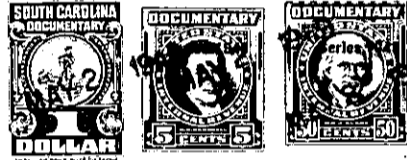
That I, W. W. Hellams

All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land in Greenville Township and Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Beattie and Railroad Streets, being known and designated as lots nos. 17 and 18, as shown on plat of W. A. Bates Richland Hill lots, made by Will D. Neves, Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book C, page 228, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Beattie Street at corner of lot no. 16, and running thence a long line of lots of 16 and 15 S. 48 - 15 W. 204 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Railroad Street; thence along northeast side of Railroad Street in a northeasterly direction 40.2 ft to an iron pin at corner of lot no. 19; thence along line of lots 19 and 20 N. 48 - 15E. 185.2 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Beattie Street; thence along southeast side of Beattie Street S. 41 - 15 W. 40 Feet to the beginning corner.
