County, State of South Carolina, on both sides of Jamison's Mill Creek. Beginning on a large white oak 3x old Running thence S. 44 1/2 E. 7.70 ch. to a stone; thence N. 35 3/4 E. 32.14 ch. to stone in place of hickory now gone, thence S. 83 1/2 W. 14.30 chs. to a pine stump; thence South 34 W. 19.80 chs. to a stone; thence S. 34 1/2 E. 2.76 chs. to the beginning corner, containing twenty seven and one sixth (27 1/6) acres, more or less, known as the A. C. Campbell land, now known as the J. M. Blackwell Estate;

ALSO: Lot No. 2 of and in County and State aforesaid known as the J. T. Turner Tract of land. Beginning at a large white oak 3x, on branch on E. C.
