of South Carolina, in the Town of Fountain Inn, known and designated as Lot
 No. 37, Block 3, in the subdivision of the lands of said Fountain Inn
 Manufacturing Company and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Sixth Street at corner
 of Hamby property and running thence with line of Hamby property,
