in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Johnston, his heirs and assigns forever;

All those certain pieces, parcels, or lots of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Butler Township on the east side of Gladys Drive, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 12, 13, 14 and 15, of a subdivision known as "Gladacres", as shown on plat thereof made by Pickell and Pickell, on April 15, 1946 and recorded in the R. L. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 13, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Gladys Drive at the corner of Lot No. 11, which point is 550 feet South of the intersection of the Airport Road, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 11, N. 58-31 E. 250.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot; thence S. 34-00 E. 200.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the line of that lot, S. 58-31 W. 260.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the east side of Gladys Drive; thence along the east side of said Gladys Drive, N. 31-09 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
