I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Arrie Gilliam, et al,

on or about the 30th day of March in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-nine exhibited their
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against
Rosamond Bennett, Jr., et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 9th day of May 1949,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Gary Fuller and Laura Fuller
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$4000.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Gary Fuller and Laura Fuller

"All that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville, County
and State aforesaid, Being shown as Lots Nos. 19, 20, 21, 22 and 15
feet of Lot No. 23, on the Plat of the property of W. A. Bates, re-
corded in Plat Book "C", at Page 226, and being more particularly des-
cribed by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Foster Street, at
the corner of Lot No. 19, and running thence with the Northern side
of Foster Street, S. 62-15 E. 197 feet to a pin in front line of Lot
No. 23, said pin being 15 feet distant from the joint corner of Lots
Nos. 22 and 23; thence through the line of Lot No. 23, N. 30-30 E. 136,
feet, more or less, to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 23; thence
N. 68-30 W. 88 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-30 W. 161 feet to an
iron pin; thence S. 34 W. 10 feet to iron pin on Foster Street, the
point of beginning. Said premises being the same conveyed to Lula
Mitchell by deeds recorded in Book of Deeds 104, at Page 254, and Book
of Deeds 106, at Page 29."
