all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying near the Brushy Creek Road and South
therefrom, and designated as Lots Nos. 26, 27 and 28 on a Plat
of the Property of the Sam H. James Estate, by H.L. Dunahoo,
