and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to C. S. Murry and Rosa Murry
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$2500.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said C. S. Murry and Rosa Murry

"All that lot of land, with the improvements thereon, in
Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
about four miles northwest of Greer, and on the north side of the road
leading from Chick Springs to St. Marks Church, adjoining lands now or
formerly of W. H. McCauley, Estate of Jacob Hodge, deceased; and being
all of Lot #1 as shown on plat by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, January 21,
1931, and having the following courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at iron pin in center of said road (iron pin being
on McCauley's line); thence with said line, N. 23-15 .. five hundred
fifteen and five-tenths (515.5) feet to a sweetgum stump; thence N.
13.57 E. one hundred fifty-seven and one-tenth (157.1) feet to iron
pin on McCauley's line and corner of Lot #2; thence with line of #2
Lot, S. 45-67 E. four hundred fifty-seven (457) feet to iron pin in
center of said road, and corner of lots 2-4-5; thence with the said
road, S. 26-54 W. three hundred ninety-five (395) feet to the beginning

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
