Crenshaw, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of High Valley Boulevard near the City of Greenville, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lots 34 and 35, Section 1, Plat of Fresh Meadow Farms, made by M. H. Woodward, May 21, 1945, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book M, page 127 (see also Plat Book S, page 61), and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of High Valley Boulevard at joint front corner of Lots 33 and 34 and running thence along the line of Lot 33 N. 72-55 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-05 E. 145.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 36 S. 72-55 W. 300 feet to an iron pin on the East side of High Valley Boulevard; thence with the East side of High Valley Boulevard N. 17-05 W. 145.2 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is subject to the restrictive covenants applicable to Fresh Meadow Farms which are now of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 289, page 8.
