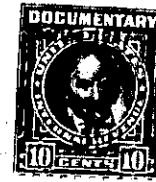

 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released,  
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Dalton Reece,  
his heirs and assigns forever:- \_\_\_\_\_

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville  
 County, State of South Carolina, School District 11-A, containing ten (10)  
 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances,  
 to-wit:-

Beginning at iron pin in the center of the Berry's Mill Road, corner-  
 ing with Rollins, formerly Forrester; and runs thence with that line,  
 N 49-45 W 16.22 chains to iron pin on the west side of branch, corner-  
 ing with Charlie Littlefield; thence along and with the meanderings of  
 the said branch to a Maple and Poplar on the branch, and on the edge of  
 a proposed thirty-foot road to be cut along the same; thence with the  
 said proposed road to the corner of the three-acre lot of J. A. Benne-  
 field, and thence with his line to the first mentioned road running to  
 Berry's Mill; thence with the Berry's Mill Road to the beginning corner  
 and bounded on the Northeast by lands of Rollins, formerly Forrester;  
 on the southeast by lands of McAbee, separated therefrom by said road;  
 southwest by lands of J. A. Bennefield; and northwest by lands of  
 Littlefield, separated therefrom by the branch: the thirty-foot road  
 referred to in the second course first above shall remain open.
