all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about two miles north from Green, lying
on the northern side of the C.C.C. road, being triangular in
shape, and being bounded on the west by lands of Upton (formerly
Mrs. Eula Mayfield) in the northeast by other lands of myself,
on the southeast by the said road and lands formerly of J. A.
Burnett, and being a part of the same tract that was conveyed
to me by deed from C. L. Belue, and recorded in the office
of the R. M. C. in Deed Book 353 at page 331, and having
the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a stake on the south edge of the surfacing
of the said road, joint corner of the Upton tract, and runs
thence with the Upton line N. 10-45 W. 29.5 feet to an iron
pin on the northern bank of the road, then continuing with
the same course-N. 10-45 W. a total of 508 feet to an iron
pin on my original line and joint corner of the Upton tract;
thence a new line S. 47-19 E. 397 feet to a nail and stopper
in the center of the said road (iron pin back on line at 20
feet); thence with the said road S. 40-15 W. 300 feet to the
beginning corner, and containing One and Thirty Five One-hundred-
ths (1.35) acres, more or less.
