Beginning at a dogwood 3X and running thence S. 86-08 E. 563.6 feet to stake; thence N. 10-10 E. 852.7 feet to stone; thence N. 9-45 E. 417.7 feet to iron pin; thence S. 64-49 E. 828.4 feet to an iron pin on plantation road; thence with plantation road S. 25-30 W. 946.7 feet to the beginning, containing 16.9 acres, more or less.
