All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the Morthwest side of Mills Avenue in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as a part of Annie M. Moore Property on plat made by H. Olin Jones, Surveyor, May 1914, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Look C, at pages 178 and 179, and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by A. C. Crouch, Engineer, June 15, 1949, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Mills Avenue, said pin being 226 feet in a Southwesterly direction from the point where the Northwest side of Mills Avenue intersects with the Southwest side of Augusta Street and running thence 1. 35-41 W. 134.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 63-33 W. 60.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 35-41 E. 145 feet to an iron pin on the orthwest side of Mills Avenue; thence along the Northwest side of Tills Avenue, N. 53-57 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of J. Mack Woods dated June 26, 1948, recorded in the R. H. C. Office for Green-ville County, S. C., in Deed Book 351, page 317.
