All that lot in what is now the city of Greenville, Greenville County,
South Carolina, which is shown as Block M, Lot 1 on plat of Highland
Terrace, Hindman Development, addition to Greenville, S. C., compiled
by W. J. Riddle, October, 1936 and recorded in Plat Book K at Pages
120-122. From this plat the following description is taken:

Beginning on the eastern side of North Main St. at the intersection of
said street and an unnamed street, and then running along the southern
edge of this unnamed street S. 87-33 E. 127.5'; thence continuing the
same S. 82-09 E. 63.8' to the rear corner of lot 1; thence running
the rear line of this lot S. 14-47 W. 95.2' to the joint rear corner
between lots 1 and 2, which latter lot I have heretofore conveyed to
the grantee; thence the joint line between these lots N. 75-13 W. 187.5'
to their joint front corner on N. Main St.; thence along the eastern
edge of said street N. 14-47 E. 60' to the beginning corner.
