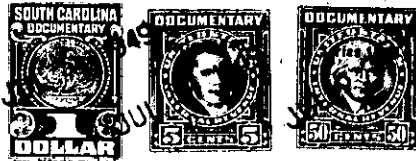

That I, T. J. Ingle, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred (300) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. W. Swindle, the following described property, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Lark Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 47 of property of the Estate of J. Rowley Yowm according to plat of W. J. Riddle, Engineer, on file in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book J, Pages 258 and 259, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the Western side of Lark Avenue, joint Eastern corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence with Lark Avenue, N. 30-55 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint Eastern corner of Lots 46 and 47; thence along the dividing line of said lots, S. 60-00 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 46 and 47, 32 and 33; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 47, S. 30-55 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 47, 48, 32, and 31; thence along the dividing line of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, N. 60-00 E. 190 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to me by deed of Annie S. Westbrook by deed dated April 6, 1946, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 293, Page 475.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
