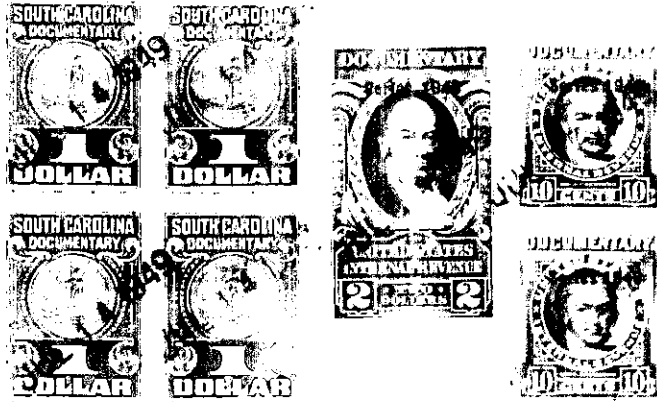

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry Jacob Jones
of Greenville County
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty
no/100 (1,950.00) and other considerations Dollars
to me

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. T. Bridges

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, located 8 miles from the Greenville County
Court House about 2 miles from the Rocky Creek Baptist Church on
the old Woodruff Road, with the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of road and at the
corner of the L. L. Bridges farm and the Smith's land, thence
thence with said road S. 9 3/4 N. 4.07 chains to an iron pin,
corner of an improved road; thence with said improved road
N. 68 W. 4.07 chains to an iron pin on corner of Smith's land;
thence with the line of Smith's land N. 74 3/4 E. 2.11 chains to
an iron pin, still on line of Smith; thence N. 21 E. 1.11 chains
to the beginning corner, the above described tract being
the L. L. Bridges farm and containing .66 more, more or less,
being the same tract of land conveyed to Henry Jacob Jones
L. L. Bridges by deed dated Jan. 21, 1946, recorded in
County Court House R. M. C. Office in Vol. 287, page 103. It is
likewise the same tract as conveyed to Henry Jacob Jones
