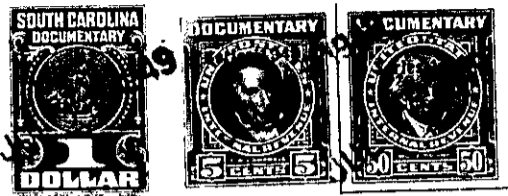

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. J. P. Waldrop, Jr.,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 68 of
Paris Piney Park according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. I. C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", page 19. Reference
to said plat is hereby craved for a complete description to said
property, said property having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at the joint corners of Lots Nos. 68 and 4
on the South side of Orlando Avenue and running thence
S. 65-40 W. along the rear lines of lots Nos. 4, 3, 2
and I, 182.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear
corners of Lots Nos. 68 and I; running thence S. 55-30 E.
142.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corners of
Lots Nos. 68 and 69; thence along the joint lines of Lots
68 and 69 N. 34-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the South
